Conditions

- Some instrumental lessons may be oversubscribed. We will always do our best to accommodate requests but it may be necessary for your child to be placed on a waiting list.
- Fees for the academic year will be charged at £25.50 per 30 minutes and will be invoiced at the end of each term. It is expected that children will have 30 lessons throughout the course of the year.
- Parents will be charged for missed lessons if their child is absent from school.
- Where appropriate, additional charges will be made (at cost) for examination fees and music books.
- It is the pupils' responsibility to ensure that class work missed, due to individual music lessons, is caught up with.
- Parents are strongly advised to ensure that insurance is arranged for their child's instruments. No liability can be taken for lost/stolen/broken instruments left at school.
- Teachers accompanying pupils for their exams will charge the full lesson fee.
- Timetables are online. Pupils in Year 3-6 are responsible for arriving at their lesson on time. Younger pupils will be fetched.

In conformity with the regulations of the Incorporated Society of Musicians we must insist:

1. A term's notice is given of intention to discontinue lessons.
2. Pupils in their first term of learning have until the end of the first half term to decide if they wish to continue.
3. All pupils, wherever possible, will rotate through a variety of lessons, thus minimising the disruption to their academic lessons.
